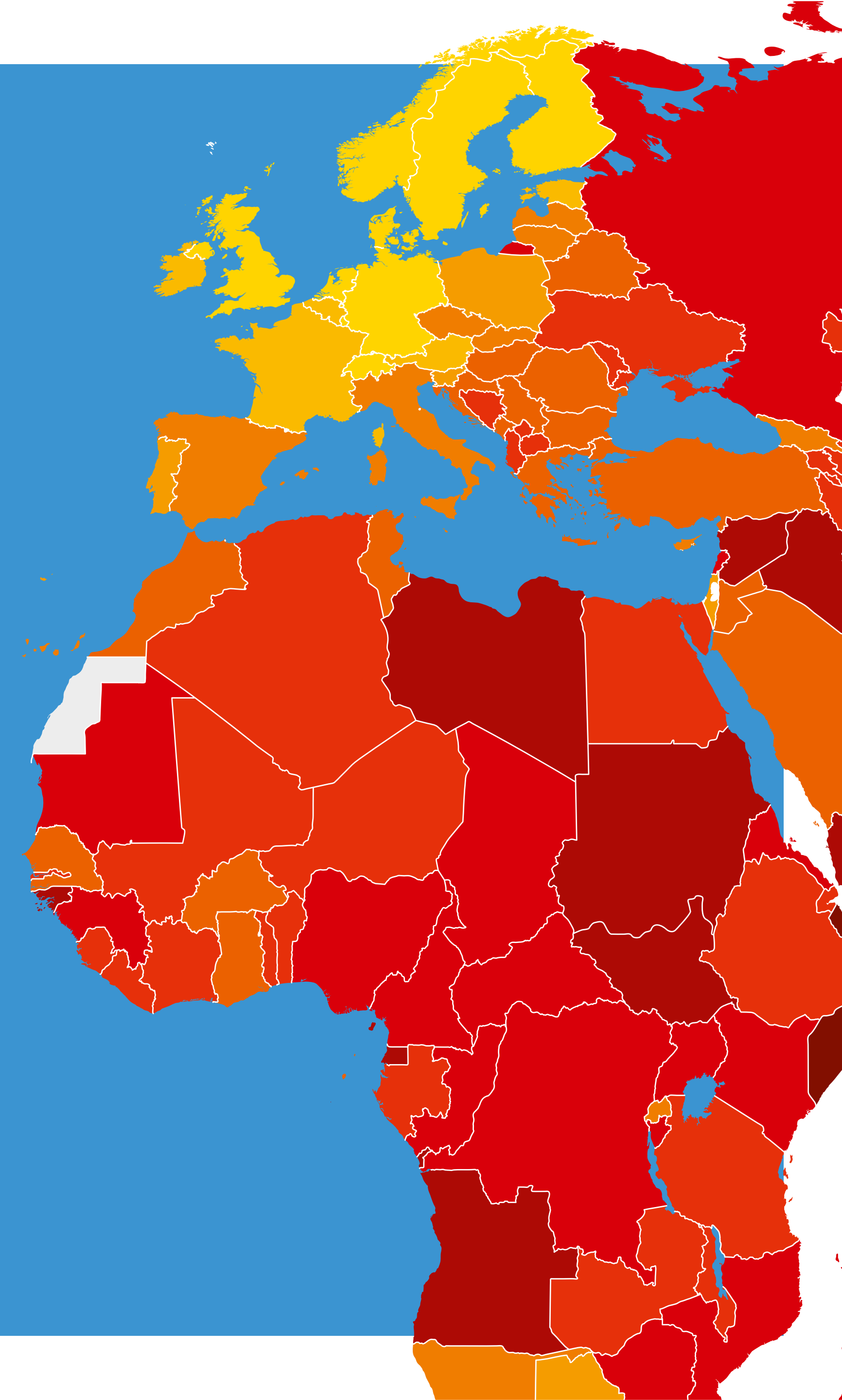

# WHO DOES THE RESEARCH AND FOR HOW LONG?

---

CPI is a study by the anti-corruption network  
Transparency International

from 1995



# WHAT IS THE STUDY BASED ON?

---

The study is based on the survey of experts and business representatives (namely, concerning corruption perception)

Transparency International does not conduct surveys.

It aggregates the results of other studies.



# WHAT KIND OF STUDY CAN BECOME A SOURCE FOR CPI?

---

- Conducted by a reputable institution
- Includes a significant number of countries
- Conducted at least once per two years

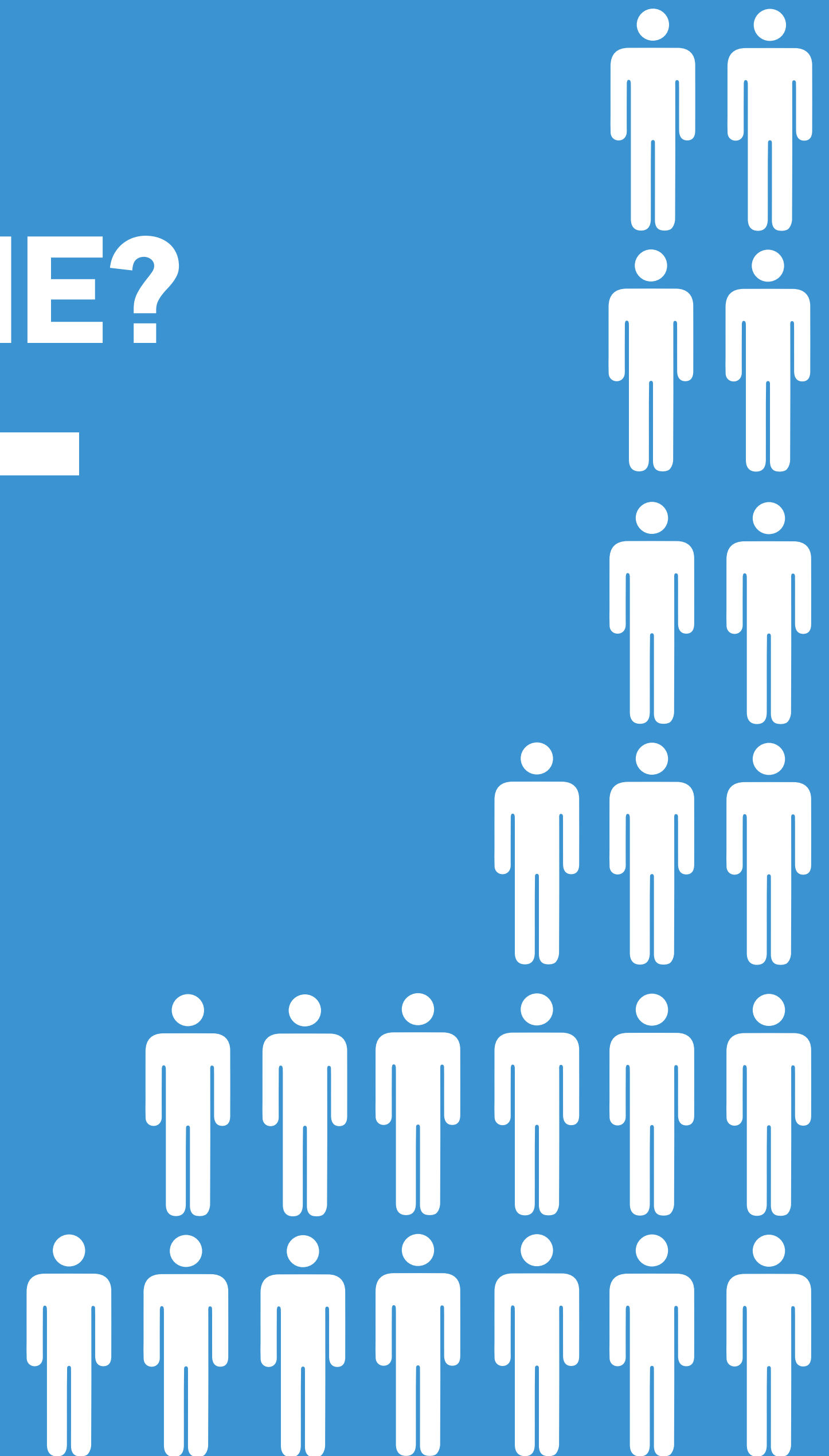
# WHAT STUDIES ASSESS CPI RESULT FOR UKRAINE?

Country Risk Rating**



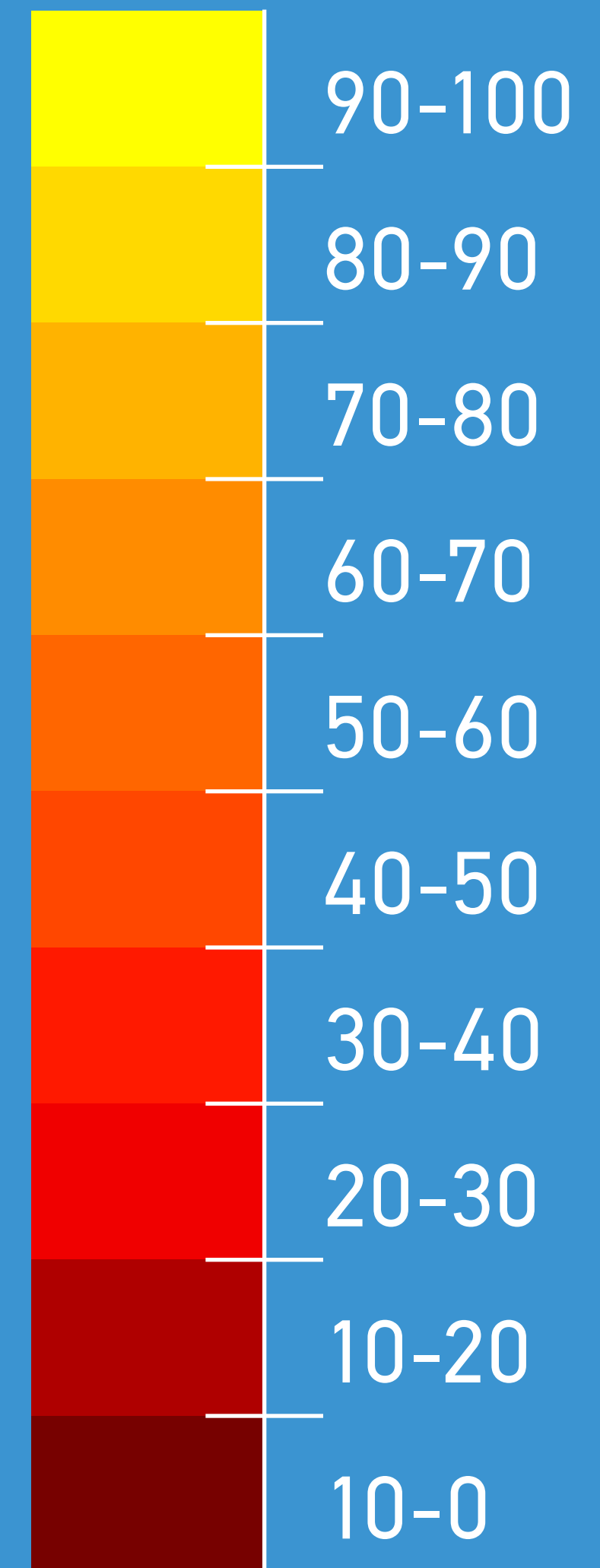
# CPI POINTS

## calculation and interpretation

The aggregate result (on the scale from 0 to 100) of all studies

**0** - corruption replaces the state

**100** - corruption almost nonexistent





# SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY DEPENDING ON ITS CPI RESULT

---

- 0-30** a significant level of corruption
- 31-60** the country is trying to combat corruption
- 61-90** corruption does not influence the state significantly
- 91-100** corruption is insignificant
